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About the Author

Raimon Panikkar (Barcelona, 1918) encompasses a multitude of cultures: Indian, European, Hindu and Christian, scientific and liberal. He graduated in Chemistry, Philosophy and Theology and became priest in 1946. He has held classes and seminars in the main university of Europe, India and America. He is a member of the International Institute of Philosophy and founded a number of philosophy magazines and centres for intercultural studies. He lives in retreat in the Catalan mountains where he leads both a contemplative and active life. He published various books and articles on topics ranging from the philosophy of science and metaphysics and comparative theology and religion. He received the “To a master of our time” Nonino Prize in 2001. With Jaca Book, he published *La pienezza dell'uomo.
